Glistening fruitcake and fine cedar oak and sweet meat burnt bits: classy dense cabernet sauvignon this. Autumn leafy too with plug tobacco. Wow: this a cabernet sauvignon of massive proportion in the mouth, and yet it is still approachable and mouth-watering. Fruitcake, anise, fine sapid oack characters; grip, length, power. A wine with at least 20 years ahead of it. Sublime.

5 Stars. Top 100. A house style with gradual improvements each year, a world class wine, St Estephe-like aromas of black currant and stalk character. It has depth, concentration and complexity in small and large berry fruit with great length and evenness.

## Gourmet Traveller Wine

A blend of cabernet sauvignon, petit verdot and malbec. Very youthful, concentrated and dark, it shows intense red and dark fruit aromas, liberal French oak, and has a slightly chewy, thick density in the mouth.

JamesSuckling.com James Suckling 93 points Aromas of blackberry, black olive and currant follow through to a full body, firm and chewy with a linear backbone and a driven finish. Still chewy. A blend of 77% cabernet, 13% petit verdot and 10% malbec. Screw cap. Drink up.

Wine Advocate Joe Czerwinski 92 points

The 2008 Heytesbury, a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec and Petit Verdot, retains a dark garnet color, just beginning to brick at the rim. It also retains its firm tannins, giving it a drying finish even at nine years of age. It's medium to full in body with a fine degree of elegance to its notes of cassis, earth, mint and vanilla. Drink it over the next several years.
